Working with select vineyards across key Sonoma AVAs, the portfolio emphasizes balance, freshness, and varietal clarity - from vibrant Chardonnay and expressive Pinot Noir to polished, approachable Cabernet Sauvignon. Owned by the Lawson family and guided by a collaborative winemaking team, the focus is on consistency, thoughtful sourcing, and wines that are authentic to Sonoma.

A Cool Place to Grow Grapes

Sonoma Coast is defined by its cool, maritime climate and rugged coastal influence, making it especially well-suited for Pinot Noir. Persistent fog, wind and cooler daytime temperatures slow ripening and extend the growing season, helping preserve acidity and aromatic detail. These conditions encourage lower yields and more gradual flavor development, contributing to wines with structure and freshness rather than weight. Our Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir is known for balance, nuance, and a clear expression of this appellation year after year.

Tasting Notes:

Bright layers of black cherry and blueberry, supported by subtle earth and dried herb notes. Fresh and balanced on the palate with bright acidity, lighter tannins and a refined texture that keeps the wine lifted and expressive. Savory undertones add depth through a clean focused finish. Pairs naturally with grilled salmon, mushroom-forward dishes, roasted vegetables or herb-accented poultry.
